



**VI. HEALTH HAZARD AND FIRST AID INFORMATION**

ROUTES OF ENTRY	EFFECTS OF OVEREXPOSURE
INHALATION	None known at low temperature and low pressure.
EYE CONTACT	May cause moderate irritation.
SKIN CONTACT	Direct or prolonged contact may cause irritation and local redness.
INGESTION	Moderately toxic. May cause painful sensations in abdomen.

**EMERGENCY FIRST AID PROCEDURES**

INHALATION	Move to fresh air, seek medical attention.
EYES	Flush eyes with water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention if warranted.
SKIN	Wash area with water, remove contaminated clothing, and launder before reuse. Get medical attention if warranted.
INGESTION	DO NOT INDUCE VOMITTING. Get medical attention immediately. Never give an unconscious person anything to ingest.

**VII. OCCUPATIONAL CONTROL PROCEDURES**

VENTILATION	General room ventilation is satisfactory for use at low temperature. Provide local exhaust as necessary.
RESPIRATORY	None required at low temperatures.
EYE PROTECTION	Safety glasses or goggles are advisable where splashes to eye may occur.
SKIN PROTECTION	Latex gloves are advisable.
HANDLING AND STORAGE	Keep containers closed when not in use.

SPILL AND LEAK PROCEDURES	Dike area with absorbent to contain spill.
WASTE DISPOSAL METHODS	Dispose of and conform to applicable federal, state and local regulations.
